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## COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This one day course is designed for physicians, nurses, and other allied health professionals who are involved in the care of mothers, infants, and children. The course will focus on infections in this population, with emphasis on the impact of infections on the individual patient and the patient's family. Specific infections to be discussed include H1N1 influenza, common infections of pregnancy and childhood, and NICU nosocomial infections. The interaction between the immune system and infections at various stages of life will be discussed, along with the use of immunizations to modify this relationship.

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## LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

At the conclusion of this program, the participant will:

1. Have a better understanding of common infections in the maternal-child population
2. Recognize the impact of these infections on the infected patient and the patient's family and community
3. Understand the relationship between the immune system and common infections at various stages of life along with the use of immunizations to modify this relationship
